In South Africa, most children receive palliative care at home and are visited by a home based carer trained in children's palliative care. However, palliative care can be offered in a clinic, a hospital, and where available, in a children's hospice. There are a number of adult hospices who also offer care to children.

Two studies estimated the need for children's palliative care in Africa. In the first study the rate of need was reported as 3.75 times higher in Kenya, 4.75 times higher in South Africa, and 5.6 times higher in Zimbabwe than in the United Kingdom [37].
