DOT Physical Exam Requirements

Due to the strict DOT physical requirements, commercial operators are generally required to pass the CDL physical exam on a regular basis. For example, in order to maintain the validity of commercial licenses in Vermont, drivers will be required to pass the DOT physical exam on a two-year basis, as mandated by federal regulations.

A Department of Transportation (DOT) physical examination must be conducted by a licensed "medical examiner" listed on the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) National Registry. The term includes, but is not limited to, doctors of medicine (MD), doctors of osteopathy (DO), physician assistants (PA), advanced practice nurses (APN), and doctors of chiropractic (DC).

Hearing. General physical exam. A DOT physical can cover up to twelve different categories of wellness, ranging from neurological to vascular. The driver may be asked to bring past medical records, and even correctional devices such as eye glasses, contacts or hearing aids to their DOT physical.

The DOT requires each commercial truck driver to pass a physical exam, stating that you are in good enough health to operate heavy machinery safely on the roads. The basic requirements for passing a DOT physical exam are: With or without vision corrections, each eye, as well as both eyes combined, need to have 20/40 vision. Ability to distinguish color is necessary. Hearing needs to be good enough to notice a forced whisper at a minimum distance of 5 feet.

The recommended (not required) minimum waiting period for DOT physical after a stroke is one year for a stroke without risk for seizure, eg cerebellar or brainstem, but 5 yrs for cerebral stroke. Maximum recommended certification is one year.
