Difference between Automatic vs Manual vs CVT gearbox ...

The main difference in operating a car with a stick shift vs. one with automatic transmission is that you need to shift gears based on the vehicle's speed and this requires the use of the clutch pedal and the gear shift (stick). When the clutch pedal is depressed the clutch is disengaged - the engine and the transmission is separated.

Manual vs. automatic transmission
