Regex Cheat Sheet

A regular expression (regex or regexp for short) is a special text string for describing a search pattern. You can think of regular expressions as wildcards on steroids. You are probably familiar with wildcard notations such as *.txt to find all text files in a file manager. The regex equivalent is «.*\.txt» .

A common pitfall in Ruby's regular expressions is to match the string's beginning and end by ^ and \$, instead of \A and \z. Ruby uses a slightly different approach than many other languages to match the end and the beginning of a string.
