The study of Anglo-Saxon art, however defined chronologically, has a long history, although until early 21st century theoretical perspectives have been lacking, with most studies focusing on style, medium, iconography, and, less often, patronage. Though the Renaissance period that followed reverted to the values of classical art, the 19th century saw a renewed interest and understanding of medieval art, highlighting its vast achievements in fine art and architecture. This was due in large part to a relatively new academic field of study—art history—which concentrated heavily on medieval art, and worked hard to date surviving works and analyze the development of many of the styles that came out of the era.
