Ohio State Penitentiary guards used electricity as a form of punishment, creating a complete circuit with a tub of water, the inmate, and a battery [vi]. This led to the creation of the electric chair, officially introduced in 1889. New York became the first state to adopt this method and abandon hanging, and by 1950, 26 states had followed [vii].
